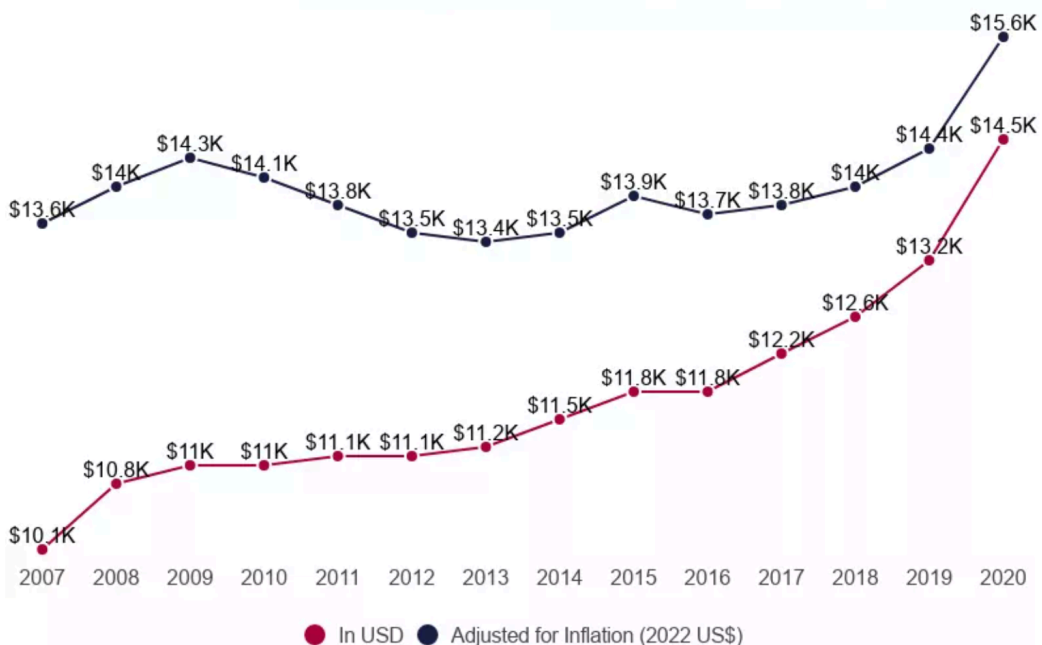

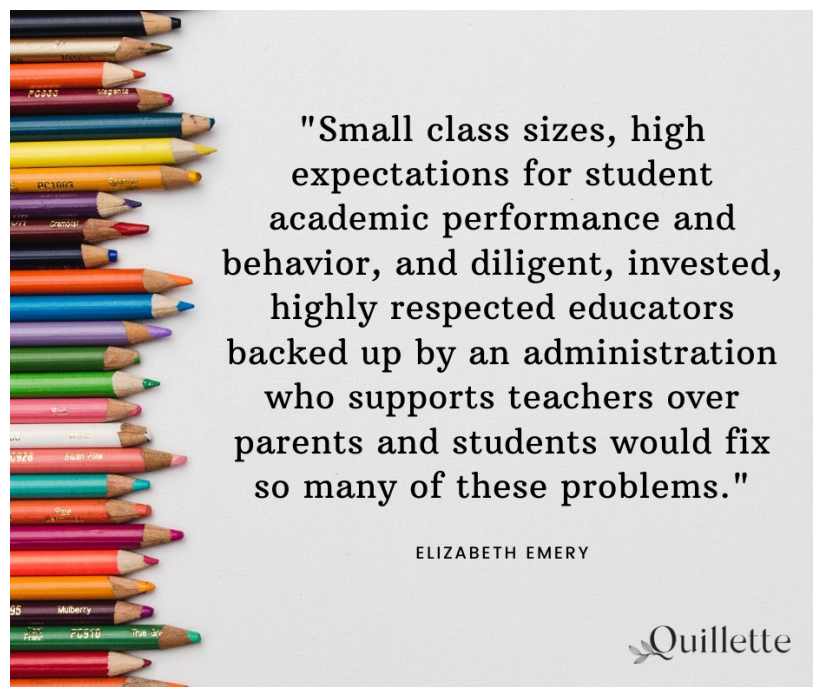
Odds of a US High School Athlete playing Pro Sports
